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Das Seminar vermittelt Techniken der theoretischen Erfassung der syntaktischen Distribution argumentkodierender Marker (Kasus- oder Kongruenz-Marker) in typologisch unterschiedlichen Sprachen, mit einem Schwerpunkt auf ungewöhnlichen Phänomenen der Argumentkodierung. Im Hintergrund steht als Rahmen die Theorie der Minimalistischen Syntax, einer syntaktischen Theorie für die distribuierte Morphologie.
